Future Leaders must subscribe to our Statement of Belief:

- 1. The Bible is the written Word of God, and because it is inspired throughout, all its assertions are historically and scientifically true in the original autographs. To the student of nature this means that the account of origins in Genesis is a factual presentation of simple historical truths.
- 2. All basic types of living things, including man, were made by direct creative acts of God during the Creation Week described in Genesis. Whatever biological changes have occurred since Creation Week have accomplished only changes within the original created kinds.
- 3. The great flood described in Genesis, commonly referred to as the Noachian Flood, was an historic event worldwide in its extent and effect.
- 4. We are an organization of Christian men and women of science who accept Jesus Christ as our Lord and Savior. The account of the special creation of Adam and Eve as one man and one woman and their subsequent fall into sin is the basis for our belief in the necessity of a Savior for all mankind. Therefore, salvation can come only through accepting Jesus Christ as our Savior.

About the Creation Research Society

A number of important principles were established by us in the beginning of our organization's history. First, members of the Society, which include research scientists from various fields of scientific accomplishment, are committed to full belief in the biblical record of creation and early history. Thus, they advocate the concept of special creation (as opposed to evolution), both of the universe and of the earth with its complexity of living forms. All members must subscribe to the Society's statement of belief.

Second, the CRS is unaffiliated with any other organization. In view of the widely divergent church backgrounds of Society members, there is no affiliation of the CRS with any religious group or church body. Obviously, members of the Society are encouraged to participate as individuals in church-related activities.

Third, the essential purpose of the CRS is to research and publish ideas that support creation as an alternate view of origins. The main publication of the Society is the *Creation Research Society Quarterly (CRSQ)*, a peer-reviewed journal which emphasizes original research and the reinterpretation of existing scientific data within the creationist framework. The journal carries both technical and popular articles in most major scientific and allied disciplines, and thus is of interest to individuals from a wide range of backgrounds. The *CRSQ* continues to be recognized worldwide as the premier journal in its field. We also produce a bimonthly publication (*Creation Matters*), containing more popular-level articles.

In the area of research, the Society has established an experiment station, the Van Andel Creation Research Center (VACRC), in north-central Arizona for the purpose of aiding the Society and other visiting scientists in their research efforts. The Society encourages a broad spectrum of research to develop and test a creation model, and administers a research grant program whereby modest funds are approved and distributed to qualified researchers for the conduct and publication of creation-related research.

In recent years, the CRS has sponsored meetings for CRS members. The highlight of the event is the Henry M. Morris Memorial Lecture, featuring a well-known creationist speaker. During these two-to-three-day conferences, members are encouraged to give short presentations regarding new concepts and cutting-edge research in creation science.

Finally, being primarily a research and publishing Society, the CRS does not engage in any lobbying or political activity. Individual members may, of course, exercise their constitutional rights regarding local, state, and national governments.
